

PARENTAL REFUSAL TO PROVIDE INFORMATION

In general, undergraduate students are considered dependent for financial aid purposes until they reach age 24, unless they qualify for other exceptions or have unusual circumstances that prevent them from contacting their parents. Dependent students whose parents refuse to provide information on the FAFSA **do not** qualify for Federal Pell Grant or Direct Subsidized loan and must submit the parent acknowledgement below.

By signing below I acknowledge the following:

- I understand that providing information for my son/daughter to complete the FAFSA does not obligate me to provide any financial support for educational expenses.
- I understand that my son/daughter will only be considered for unsubsidized loans (interest accruing from date of disbursement).
- I am not providing any financial support (including auto or medical insurance).
- I am not claiming my son/daughter as a dependent for income tax purposes.
- I refuse to provide information necessary for my son/daughter to complete the FAFSA.
